El Verano Community Crisis Home (CCH) serves adults ages 18 and over with complex needs who might also have mental health symptoms. El Verano CCH provides services to individuals who need help transitioning safely out of a locked setting into a less restrictive community, are having problems living in their current home, or who want to practice safe living skills so they can return to the home of their choice.

El Verano CCH is not a forever home. Residents can live at El Verano CCH for up to 18 months. We focus on helping each resident prepare for their next home where they can live for a longer period of time.

Our services emphasize choice-making skills and positive behavior support strategies based on each resident's unique needs and capabilities. Every resident will have their own behavior support team that will include professionals specific to their individualized plan, such as a program administrator, licensed vocational nurses (LVN), registered behavior technicians (RBT), licensed clinicians, occupational and physical therapists, and medical support staff, as well as their identified personal circle of support.

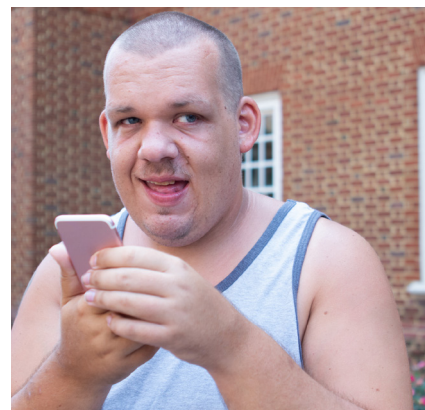
What to Expect

El Verano CCH is a beautiful four-bedroom home where residents each have their own bedroom and can explore a variety of interests such as cooking, gardening, budgeting, and practicing living skills to be as independent as possible. Our staff can even arrange outside activities such as going to school, attending a day program, or other fun events on a case-by-case basis.

Our culture is based on respect and non-judgment, and we celebrate individual uniqueness. We care about the interpersonal relationships we develop so we can maintain a supportive program setting.

Services at El Verano CCH

Services at El Verano CCH include, but are not limited to:

- Behavior support to ensure safety in the home and community
- Therapy to build skills to help with stress or trauma
- Activities of daily living and social skills training
- Physical health and substance use education
- Medication support and education
- Structured on-site programming including physical, recreational, social, artistic, therapeutic, spiritual, and skills development
- Community outings
- Visits to community service providers such as day treatment services or healthcare professionals
- Transition planning to prepare residents for their next home
