About the Program:	<p>The Supported E&T is designed for individuals who are 18 or older currently involuntarily detained under RCW 71.05, who have intellectual or developmental disabilities, and who are actively enrolled with the Developmental Disabilities Administration of Washington and are currently in need of psychiatric stabilization in an Evaluation and Treatment center. We specialize in working with individuals who are looking for rapid stabilization of psychiatric symptoms so that they may return to their existing level of care or residential provider. Individuals with co-occurring behavioral health conditions and ID/DD coming to an E&T often face multiple barriers to service and returning home. In addition to focusing on treatment goals related to medication and internal management of psychiatric symptomology, the team is prepared to address habilitation needs and building skill sets that support successful community living. We partner with an individual's residential provider to build support strategies that encourage long-term community success.</p> <p>Services are provided by a caring multidisciplinary team including nurses, social work/clinicians, a psychiatric medical provider, a chemical dependency professional, rehabilitation therapists, recovery specialists and peer recovery coaches. We offer 24-hour support, individualized assessments, collaborative treatment planning, assistance with symptom reduction, medication services, and discharge planning, all with the goal of preparing individuals to return to their communities with tools and resources that empower their recovery.</p>
