At the Riverside Psychiatric Health Facility (PHF), we provide intensive mental health and psychiatric treatment services in a safe, welcoming environment for adults experiencing a mental health emergency.

We believe recovery starts from within, and that our job is to do whatever it takes to provide the support needed on your recovery journey in a comfortable, structured environment. Our secure 16-bed facility has a multidisciplinary team that includes a psychiatrist, social workers, a rehabilitation therapist, registered nurses, recovery specialists, and peer support specialists.

Our services emphasize choice-making skills and harm-reduction techniques. We provide a safe, respectful environment where you can receive immediate, individualized assistance and a compassionate presence to stabilize symptoms, avoid the need for higher levels of care and receive appropriate referrals to community-based resources.

Your recovery plan starts with you. Upon arrival, our diverse clinical team will provide an individualized assessment and work with you every step of the way to support your goals in life.

Our culture is based on recovery. We believe in respect and non-judgment, and we celebrate individual uniqueness. We care about the interpersonal relationships we develop so we can foster a supportive program setting.

Becoming a Member

If you or a family member needs emergency mental health services, you can come to the Riverside County Crisis Stabilization Unit (CSU) program at 47915 Oasis St. Indio, CA 92201.

The PHF is connected to the CSU, which offers a resource for people who are currently experiencing a crisis, and where you will receive the first initial assessment. If you would benefit from the more intensive services of the PHF, you will then be referred into the program. Staff at the CSU will do a screening to determine if you are medically stable for admission.

Admission Criteria

All individuals will have a medical screening performed by PHF staff to determine if they are medically stable to be admitted. Individuals must be able to take medications and fluids orally, walk without assistance, and have a resting pulse below 100/minute. The following guidelines warrant an evaluation by emergency department personnel for clearance:

- Suspected or reported overdose
- Over age 64
- Chest pain or difficulty breathing
- Exhibiting signs of drug or alcohol impairment
